Recent brain function research suggests methods for teachers to better serve their diverse student groups. The inclusion of alternate learning devices, for a diverse student population, necessitates an understanding of the right-brain thinker and the need for right-brain activities for all students. Spatial, synthetic and non-linear learners, so underappreciated in too many school districts, often employ right-brain thinking. The consideration of communication in the classroom, between and among the sexes, between multicultural groups and within a homogeneous or heterogeneous setting will follow from the initial lessons. Teachers should feel better empowered to tackle challenges such as classroom anxiety, standardized testing strategies, and critical thinking embedded curricula.
